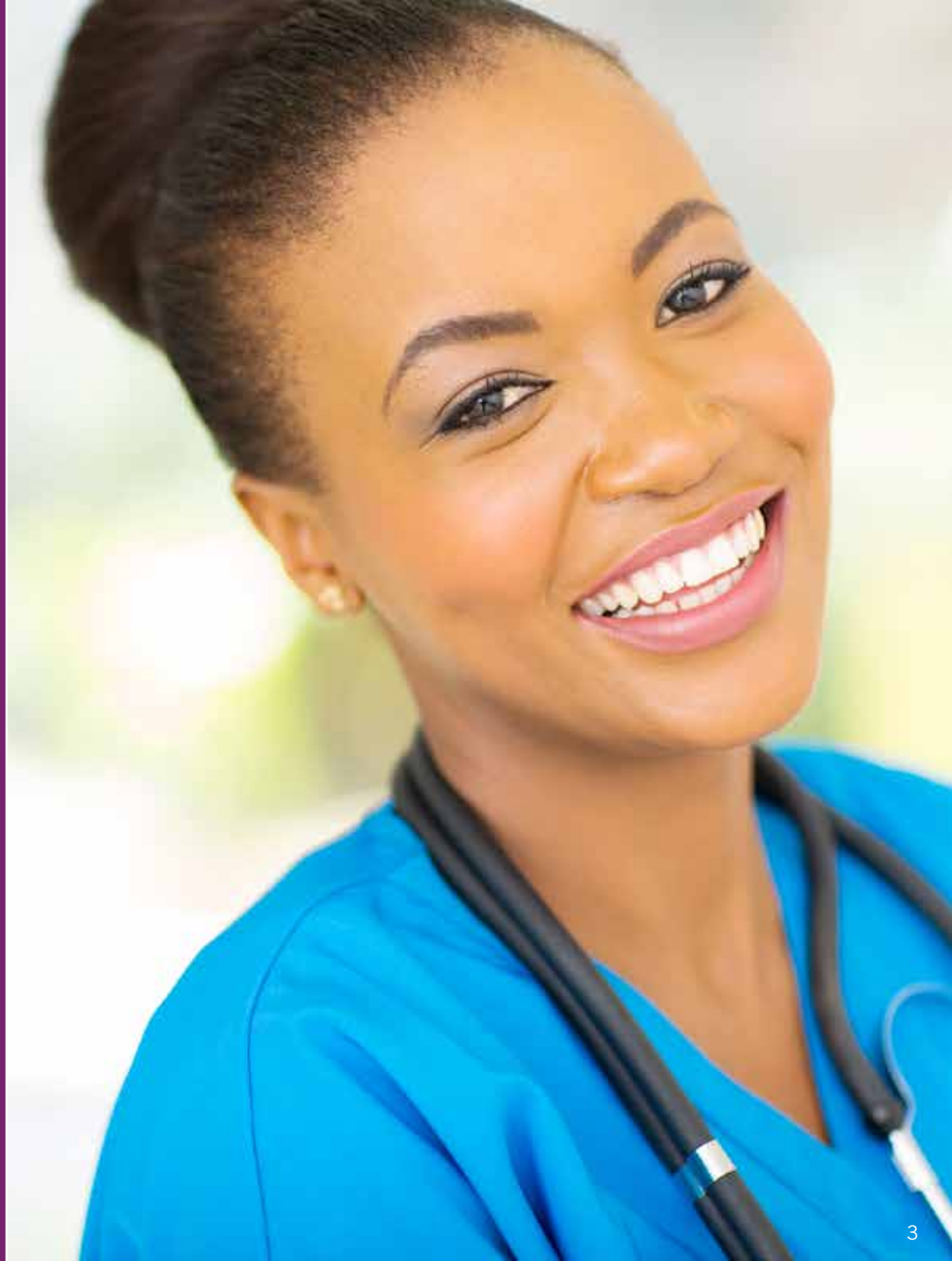

Values:

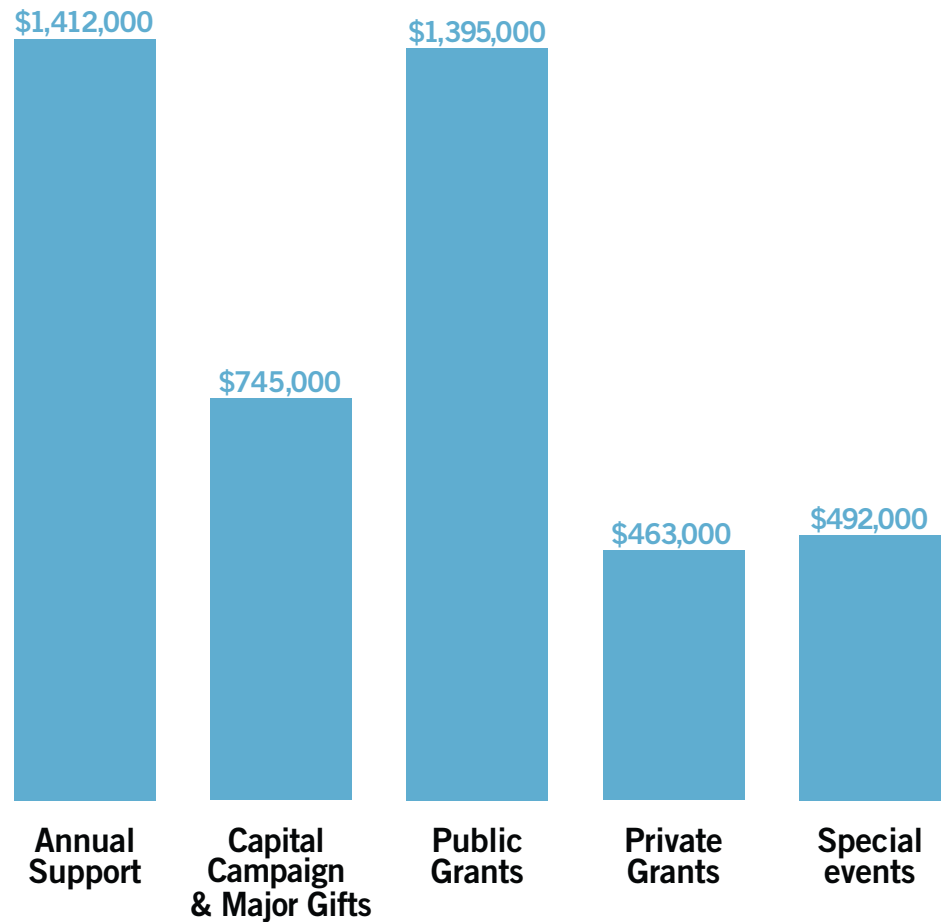
- *Dignity* - Respecting the inherent value and worth of each person.

2014 IN REVIEW

KEY INITIATIVES SUPPORTED BY ST. ROSE DOMINICAN HEALTH FOUNDATION

R.E.D. Rose

R.E.D. stands for Responsible Early Detection and the program provides free mammography, ultrasound, biopsy, and surgical consultations for individuals 49 years of age and younger who are uninsured or underinsured. The bilingual Breast Health Navigator coordinates care from screening to treatment. Support services are also available, such as payment of monthly utilities, transportation costs, groceries, rent, and other incidentals while fighting breast cancer.

Helping Hands of Henderson

Assists homebound individuals 60 years of age and older who live in Henderson. This program provides resources designed to help meet the needs of seniors living in Henderson so they can remain independent in their own home. It provides transportation to physicians, grocery shopping, pharmacy pick up, and other needed services that when combined, allow seniors to maintain independent, healthy lives.

- 34%** Improvement in our clients' ability to maintain doctor's appointments with the assistance of Helping Hands
- 100%** Improvement of seniors having to go without food due to not having transportation or access to Meals on Wheels

Disease Management Services

Promotes healthy behaviors in adults with chronic health conditions, including heart disease, stroke, and diabetes. This program's focus is to reach adults 60 years of age and older with chronic conditions, the uninsured, and the Hispanic population.

This six-week comprehensive, outcomes-based program, developed by Stanford University, includes education and action planning for participants to improve management of their chronic condition in the following areas: Taking action to manage symptoms such as pain and difficult emotions; improving nutrition, physical activity, health literacy and communication with physicians; managing medications and making appropriate plans that work with their lifestyle. Program available in English and Spanish.

Partnership for Compassionate Care – Siena Campus Patient Tower Campaign

As a partner in our community's health, the Siena Campus is where southern Nevadans turn for help. We offer high quality, evidence-based medical care delivered with compassion at life's most defining moments – its beginnings, its endings and the times when, though patients are broken by illness or injury, recovery and renewal are quite possible.

This spirit of partnership and connectivity gives life to St. Rose Dominican's ministry and has made our Siena Campus more than a hospital on a corner, but rather a cornerstone in our community. The expansion of our Siena Campus is our promise to care for our partner: the people of southern Nevada.

As careful stewards of our resources, St. Rose Dominican is able to fund the majority of the \$160 million necessary to cover the costs of our Siena Campus growth plans, which include expenditures for construction, technology and equipment, and expanded programs and services.

However, Our Partnership for Compassionate Care – Siena Campus Patient Tower Campaign will help ensure that our growth plans are fully funded and many of those in our community have responded generously to support this vitally needed expansion. Here is a snapshot of what we will accomplish... and what we have already completed:

Opening Fall/Winter 2015

- A new, five-story tower with the capacity for 100-plus adult and pediatric acute care beds
- An upgraded Emergency Room featuring 32 new treatment bays (for a total of 56) and its own designated, diagnostic imaging center
- An expanded cardiology-cardiovascular center with its own separate entrance
- Six new surgical suites (bringing the total number to 16)
- Expanded Level III Intensive Care Unit (ICU)

Completed:

- An enhanced Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) featuring 11 new private bays, a breastfeeding room and Nesting Suite for families
- A four-story, nearly 500-space parking garage

RN Residency Program

The St. Rose Dominican New RN Residency Program began in 2012 and is a 12-week combined program that includes didactic classes, support groups, and clinical preceptored training that moves the new RN from student to independent, safe, caring bedside nurse. This program trains nurses for Medical Surgical units, Intermediate Care, Pediatrics, Labor & Delivery, Oncology, Joint Replacement, and the Emergency Department.

In 2014, the program trained 52 new grads and plans to have three residency groups for 2015. Over the course of the program's history, our new nurses grow to embrace and live out 'Humankindness' in their daily practice. These grads are frequent winners of St. Rose Dominican's monthly Humankindness awards. Many of the past residents are now entering leadership-based internship programs to be trained as Critical Care nurses in the difficult practice areas of Intensive Care and Emergency Departments. This program is truly a 'Win-Win' as donations and grants help St. Rose Dominican hire the brightest new grads, and train them to be the best, caring nurses, ultimately becoming an integral part of our St. Rose Dominican Family.





Vocera Communication System

Vocera engages and empowers patients, nurses, physicians and other members of the care team with intelligent, real-time communication, allowing them to connect securely and instantly with the right person, at the right time, with the right information, regardless of location or device. The system integrates seamlessly with over 60 hospital systems, including the EHR, alarms and nurse call systems. Seamless collaboration via Vocera's enterprise-class communication platform will help St. Rose Dominican improve staff efficiency, patient safety and satisfaction as well as create a quiet healing environment where overhead announcements are no longer necessary.

Initially installed at our San Martín Campus, Vocera proved to be a vital tool to engage and empower nurses, physicians and other members of our care team to provide responsive care for our patients. With funds raised by the St. Rose Dominican Foundation, the Vocera system was not only installed at our Siena and Rose de Lima Campuses it was also upgraded at our San Martín Campus.



Children's Miracle Network Hospitals

Since 1983, Children's Miracle Network Hospitals (CMNH) has raised more than \$5 billion - most of it \$1 at a time - for 170 children's hospitals in the U.S. and Canada. Funds are raised in conjunction with over 80 corporate partners (such as Wal-Mart, Smiths, Costco, IHOP, and others), and the organization is unique in its efforts - as 100% of the money that is raised local, stays local. St. Rose Dominican is proud that in January 2005, it was designated the only CMN Hospital in the region. Since that time, we have been honored to provide much needed care and services through our facilities to the children in our community who need it the most.

In addition, the Maternal Child Centers at the San Martín and Siena Campuses are the first in southern Nevada to earn the prestigious "Baby-Friendly USA" designations. The Baby-Friendly Hospital Initiative is a global program launched by the World Health Organization (WHO) and the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) to encourage and recognize hospitals that offer an optimal level of care for infant feeding and mother/baby bonding. St. Rose Dominican is honored to have been selected to participate in this initiative as we believe it affirms our dedication to providing the highest level of maternal and pediatric care for the residents of our community.





Charity Care is Funded Primarily by Children's Miracle Network Hospitals

Charity Care is health care provided for free or at reduced prices to low-income patients.

Pediatric and Neonatal Equipment Funded by Children's Miracle Network Hospitals

Pediatric and neonatal equipment is specialized and crucial to the care and development of high-risk and critically ill infants and children. Some of this equipment includes isolettes - clear plastic enclosed cribs designed to maintain a warm environment for a new baby and isolate him or her from germs. The specialized isolettes we have at St. Rose Dominican are also able to regulate oxygen levels, humidity and temperature. Other equipment includes ventilators and oscillators to assist with breathing; IV and syringe pumps for distribution of nutrition and medication; cardiac monitors; lactation equipment and resources; transportation devices; and even appliances such as SonoSites - specialized portable ultrasound machines that assist physicians in placing central lines and catheters, thus making the procedure much more precise.

Child Life Specialist is Funded by Children's Miracle Network Hospitals

Child Life Specialists are pediatric health care professionals who work with children and families in hospitals and other settings to help them cope with the challenges of hospitalization, illness, and disability. Working in all pediatric areas of the hospital including surgery, ER, radiology, PEDS and PICU, and out-patient settings, they also provide diversions for patient siblings as frequently as for the patients themselves. Their presence has a huge impact and is critical to a positive hospital experience and healing environment for patients and their families. At St. Rose Dominican, Children's Miracle Network Hospitals provides the salary and several resources for our Child Life Specialist, Kathy Cooper.





Children's Miracle Network Hospitals Balloon Campaigns

All Year in Partnership with Local Corporate Sponsors

All year long, local organizations partner with Children's Miracle Network Hospitals to promote the familiar 'balloon campaign' that is at the heart of the organization's fundraising activities. These \$1-at-a-time fundraising campaigns have helped bring over \$7.5 million to St. Rose Dominican, allowing us to provide new pediatric equipment, charity care for patients, and health education for children.

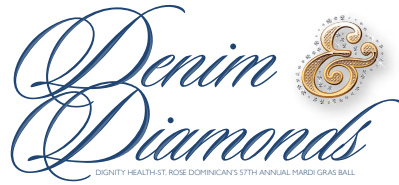
